2. Introduction /Literature Review
3. Method
4. Results
5. Discussion
6. Conclusion
7. References

Basic Structure of a Presentation

- Introduction
- Main body
- Conclusion
- References

Basic Structure of a Presentation

- **Introduction**  **What you will do** &
How you will do it
- **Main body** **Emphasize**
Repeat/ Refer what you have said (Introduction)
Give examples
Ordering points
Say it in other words
- **Conclusion** **Conclude**
Use invite questions
- **References**

Introduction

Important because the outline is given there

It is also given:

- the goal of the research or the related literature
- paper's outline
- your own thesis statement / point of view on the subject or issue

Main body 1/3

Method and/or Procedure

Explain them in detail

- Refer to the Subjects of the survey (participants)
- Mention the sample (who they are, their profile etc.)
- Report Instruments and Data gathering procedure
- Use Appendix which is a useful tool when necessary (e.g. questionnaires, charts, tables, etc.)

Results: Presenting the Data 2/3

- Students present the outcome of the research in detail
- Mention whether the paper deals with

quantitative research or **qualitative research**
(numerical data)

Discussion: Interpretation and data 3/3

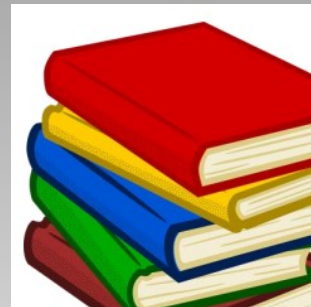
- Explanation of the research's results and reader/students point of view
- Refer to every point separately and do not mix them
- Stay focused on the main idea of the Research Paper

Conclusion

- Refer to the findings of the paper
- It's thesis statement's conclusion
- Recommendations
- Suggestions for further research/ future researchers
- Limitations

References

- List the source(s) of the information used
- In case they aren't listed there you can't avoid plagiarism
